

**There are 77 New Testament references to Israel.  
None of these references can be interpreted as meaning the church.**

- 1) Matthew 2:6 'And you, Bethlehem, land of Judah,  
Are by no means least among the leaders of Judah;  
For out of you shall come forth a Ruler  
Who will shepherd My people **Israel.**'
- 2) Matthew 2:20 "Get up, take the Child and His mother, and go into the land of **Israel..**"
- 3) Matthew 2:21 So Joseph got up, took the Child and His mother, and came into the land of **Israel.**
- 4) Matthew 8:10 Now when Jesus heard, He marveled and said to those who were following, "Truly I say to you, I have not found such great faith with anyone in **Israel.**
- 5) Matthew 9:33 After the demon was cast out, the mute man spoke; and the crowds were amazed, saying, "Nothing like this has ever been seen in **Israel.**"
- 6) Matthew 10:6 "but rather go to the lost sheep of the house of **Israel.**"
- 7) Matthew 10:23 "But whenever they persecute you in one city, flee to the next; for truly I say to you, you will not finish *going through* the cities of **Israel** until the Son of Man comes.
- 8) Matthew 15:24 But He answered and said, "I was sent only to the lost sheep of the house of **Israel.**"
- 9) Matthew 15:31 So the crowd marveled as they saw the mute speaking, the crippled restored, and the lame walking, and the blind seeing; and they glorified the God of **Israel.**
- 10) Matthew 19:28 And Jesus said to them, "Truly I say to you, that you who have followed Me, in the regeneration when the Son of Man will sit on His glorious throne, you also shall sit upon twelve thrones, judging the twelve tribes of **Israel.**"

- 11) Matthew 27:9 Then that which was spoken through Jeremiah the prophet was fulfilled: "And they took the thirty pieces of silver, the price of the one whose price had been set by the sons of **Israel**"
- 12) Matthew 27:42 "He saved others; He cannot save Himself. He is the King of **Israel**; let Him now come down from the cross, and we will believe in Him."
- 13) Mark 12:29 Jesus answered, "The foremost is, 'Hear, O **Israel**! The Lord our God is one Lord;'"
- 14) Mark 15:32 "Let *this* Christ, the King of **Israel**, now come down from the cross, so that we may see and believe!" Those who were crucified with Him were also insulting Him.
- 15) Luke 1:16 And he will turn many of the sons of **Israel** back to the Lord their God.
- 16) Luke 1:54 "He has given help to **Israel** His servant, In remembrance of His mercy"
- 17) Luke 1:68 "Blessed *be* the Lord God of **Israel**, For He has visited us and accomplished redemption for His people"
- 18) Luke 1:80 And the child continued to grow and to become strong in spirit, and he lived in the deserts until the day of his public appearance to **Israel**.
- 19) Luke 2:25 And there was a man in Jerusalem whose name was Simeon; and this man was righteous and devout, looking for the consolation of **Israel**; and the Holy Spirit was upon him.
- 20) Luke 2:32 "A Light of revelation to the Gentiles, And the glory of Your people **Israel**."
- 21) Luke 2:34 And Simeon blessed them and said to Mary His mother, "Behold, this *Child* is appointed for the fall and rise of many in **Israel**, and for a sign to be opposed— "
- 22) Luke 4:25 "But I say to you in truth, there were many widows in **Israel** in the days of Elijah, when the sky was shut up for three years and six months, when a great famine came over all the land"
- 23) Luke 4:27 "And there were many lepers in **Israel** in the time of Elisha the prophet; and none of them was cleansed, but only Naaman the Syrian."

- 24) Luke 7:9 Now when Jesus heard this, He marveled at him, and turned and said to the crowd that was following Him, "I say to you, not even in **Israel** have I found such great faith."
- 25) Luke 22:30 "that you may eat and drink at My table in My kingdom, and you will sit on thrones judging the twelve tribes of **Israel**."
- 26) Luke 24:21 "But we were hoping that it was He who was going to redeem **Israel**. Indeed, besides all this, it is the third day since these things happened."
- 27) John 1:31 "I did not recognize Him, but so that He might be manifested to **Israel**, I came baptizing in water."
- 28) John 1:47 Jesus saw Nathanael coming to Him, and said of him, "Behold, an **Israelite** indeed, in whom there is no deceit!"
- 29) John 1:49 Nathanael answered Him, "Rabbi, You are the Son of God; You are the King of **Israel**."
- 30) John 3:10 Jesus answered and said to him, "Are you the teacher of **Israel** and do not understand these things? "
- 31) John 12:13 took the branches of the palm trees and went out to meet Him, and *began* to shout, "Hosanna! Blessed is He who comes in the name of the Lord, even the King of **Israel**."
- 32) Acts 1:6 So when they had come together, they were asking Him, saying, "Lord, is it at this time You are restoring the kingdom to **Israel**?"
- 33) Acts 2:22 "Men of **Israel**, listen to these words: Jesus the Nazarene, a man attested to you by God with miracles and wonders and signs which God performed through Him in your midst, just as you yourselves know— "
- 34) Acts 2:36 "Therefore let all the house of **Israel** know for certain that God has made Him both Lord and Christ — this Jesus whom you crucified."
- 35) Acts 3:12 But when Peter saw he replied to the people, "Men of **Israel**, why are you amazed at this, or why do you gaze at us, as if by our own power or piety we had made him walk?"

- 36) Acts 4:10 ... let it be known to all of you and to all the people of **Israel**, that by the name of Jesus Christ the Nazarene, whom you crucified, whom God raised from the dead — by this *name* this man stands here before you in good health.
- 37) Acts 4:27 For truly in this city there were gathered together against Your holy servant Jesus, whom You anointed, both Herod and Pontius Pilate, along with the Gentiles and the peoples of **Israel**,
- 38) Acts 5:21 Now when the high priest and his associates came, they called the Council together, even all the Senate of the sons of **Israel**, and sent *orders* to the prison house for them to be brought.
- 39) Acts 5:31 He is the one whom God exalted to His right hand as a Prince and a Savior, to grant repentance to **Israel**, and forgiveness of sins.
- 40) Acts 5:35 And he said to them, "Men of **Israel**, take care what you propose to do with these men."
- 41) Acts 7:23 But when he was approaching the age of forty, it entered his mind to visit his brethren, the sons of **Israel**.
- 42) Acts 7:37 This is the Moses who said to the sons of **Israel**, 'God will raise up for you a prophet like me from your brethren.'
- 43) Acts 7:42 But God turned away and delivered them up to serve the host of heaven; as it is written in the book of the prophets, 'It was not to Me that you offered victims and sacrifices forty years in the wilderness, was it, O house of **Israel**?'
- 44) Acts 9:15 But the Lord said to him, "Go, for he is a chosen instrument of Mine, to bear My name before the Gentiles and kings and the sons of **Israel**"
- 45) Acts 10:36 The word which He sent to the sons of **Israel**, preaching peace through Jesus Christ (He is Lord of all)—
- 46) Acts 13:16 Paul stood up, and motioning with his hand said, "Men of **Israel**, and you who fear God, listen"

- 47) Acts 13:17 The God of this people **Israel** chose our fathers and made the people great during their stay in the land of Egypt, and with an uplifted arm He led them out from it.
- 48) Acts 13:23 From the descendants of this man, according to promise, God has brought to **Israel** a Savior, Jesus
- 49) Acts 13:24 after John had proclaimed before His coming a baptism of repentance to all the people of **Israel**.
- 50) Acts 21:28 crying out, "Men of **Israel**, come to our aid! This is the man who preaches to all men everywhere against our people and the Law and this place; and besides he has even brought Greeks into the temple and has defiled this holy place."
- 51) Acts 28:20 "For this reason, therefore, I requested to see you and to speak with you, for I am wearing this chain for the sake of the hope of **Israel**."
- 52) Romans 9:4 who are **Israelites**, to whom belongs the adoption as sons, and the glory and the covenants and the giving of the Law and the *temple* service and the promises,
- 53) Romans 9:6 But *it is* not as though the word of God has failed. For they are not all **Israel** who are *descended* from Israel;
- 54) Romans 9:6 But *it is* not as though the word of God has failed. For they are not all Israel who are *descended* from **Israel**;
- 55) Romans 9:27 Isaiah cries out concerning **Israel**, "Though the number of the sons of Israel be like the sand of the sea, it is the remnant that will be saved;"
- 56) Romans 9:27 Isaiah cries out concerning Israel, "Though the number of the sons of **Israel** be like the sand of the sea, it is the remnant that will be saved;"
- 57) Romans 9:31 but **Israel**, pursuing a law of righteousness, did not arrive at *that* law.
- 58) Romans 10:19 But I say, surely **Israel** did not know, did they? First Moses says, "I will make you jealous by that which is not a nation, By a nation without understanding will I anger you."

- 59) Romans 10:21 But as for **Israel** He says, “All the day long I have stretched out My hands to a disobedient and obstinate people.”
- 60) Romans 11:1 I say then, God has not rejected His people, has He? May it never be! For I too am an **Israelite**, a descendant of Abraham, of the tribe of Benjamin.
- 61) Romans 11:2 God has not rejected His people whom He foreknew. Or do you not know what the Scripture says in *the passage about Elijah*, how he pleads with God against **Israel**?
- 62) Romans 11:7 What then? What **Israel** is seeking, it has not obtained, but those who were chosen obtained it, and the rest were hardened;
- 63) Romans 11:25 For I do not want you, brethren, to be uninformed of this mystery — so that you will not be wise in your own estimation — that a partial hardening has happened to **Israel** until the fullness of the Gentiles has come in;
- 64) Romans 11:26 and so all **Israel** will be saved; just as it is written,  
“The Deliverer will come from Zion,  
He will remove ungodliness from Jacob.”
- 65) 1 Corinthians 10:18 Look at the nation **Israel**; are not those who eat the sacrifices sharers in the altar?
- 66) 2 Corinthians 3:7 But if the ministry of death, in letters engraved on stones, came with glory, so that the sons of **Israel** could not look intently at the face of Moses because of the glory of his face ...
- 67) 2 Corinthians 3:13 and *are* not like Moses, *who* used to put a veil over his face so that the sons of **Israel** would not look intently at the end of what was fading away.
- 68) 2 Corinthians 11:22 Are they Hebrews? So am I. Are they **Israelites**? So am I. Are they descendants of Abraham? So am I.
- 69) Galatians 6:16 And those who will walk by this rule, peace and mercy *be* upon them, and upon the **Israel** of God.
- 70) Ephesians 2:12 *remember* that you were at that time separate from Christ, excluded from the commonwealth of **Israel**, and strangers to the covenants of promise, having no hope and without God in the world.

- 71) Philippians 3:5 ... circumcised the eighth day, of the nation of **Israel**, of the tribe of Benjamin, a Hebrew of Hebrews; as to the Law, a Pharisee;
- 72) Hebrews 8:8 For finding fault with them, He says,  
"Behold, days are coming, says the Lord,  
When I will effect a new covenant  
With the house of **Israel** and with the house of Judah;
- 73) Hebrews 8:10 "For this is the covenant that I will make with the house of **Israel**  
After those days, says the Lord:  
I will put My laws into their minds,  
And I will write them on their hearts.  
And I will be their God,  
And they shall be My people."
- 74) Hebrews 11:22 By faith Joseph, when he was dying, made mention of the exodus of the sons of **Israel**, and gave orders concerning his bones.
- 75) Revelation 2:14 But I have a few things against you, because you have there some who hold the teaching of Balaam, who kept teaching Balak to put a stumbling block before the sons of **Israel**, to eat things sacrificed to idols and to commit *acts of immorality*.
- 76) Revelation 7:4 And I heard the number of those who were sealed, one hundred and forty-four thousand sealed from every tribe of the sons of **Israel**:
- 77) Revelation 21:12 It had a great and high wall, with twelve gates, and at the gates twelve angels; and names *were* written on them, which are *the names* of the twelve tribes of the sons of **Israel**.
