

God warned Israel – disobey and you will be scattered

- 1) Lev 26:14-39 *esp v33* "... I will scatter you among the nations ..."
- 2) Deut 4:25-27 *esp v27* "The Lord will scatter you among the peoples ..."
- 3) Deut 28:58-67 *esp v64* "... the Lord will scatter you among all peoples ..."

Also: Psa 106:24-27; Hos 9:1,17; Mic 5:7; Jer 9:6-19; Jer 13:19-25;
Ezek 5:5-15; Ezek 12:15; Ezek 20:23-24; Ezek 22:15

But, He always followed with promises of restoration

- 1) Lev 26:40-50 *esp v44* "When they are in the land of their enemies, I will not reject them, nor will I so abhor them as to destroy them, breaking My covenant with them ..."
- 2) Deut 4:29-31 *esp v31* "The Lord your God is a compassionate God; He will not fail you nor destroy you nor forget the covenant with your fathers which He swore to them ..."
- 3) Deut 30:1-10 *esp v4-5* If your outcasts are at the ends of the earth, from there the Lord your God will gather you, and from there He will bring you back. The Lord your God will bring you into the land which your fathers possessed, and you shall possess it ...

The regathering will be so great, they will not remember the Exodus from Egypt!

Jer 16:14-15 "Therefore behold, days are coming," declares the Lord, "when it will no longer be said, 'As the Lord lives, who brought up the sons of Israel out of the land of Egypt,'¹⁵ but, 'As the Lord lives, who brought up the sons of Israel from the land of the north and from all the countries where He had banished them.' For I will restore them to their own land which I gave to their fathers."

Jer 23:7-8 (Identical to Jer 16:14-15. The promise is repeated.)

All will be regathered:

Ezek 39:28 "I made them go into exile among the nations, and then gathered them again to their own land; and **I will leave none of them there any longer.**"

Mic 2:12 "I will surely assemble **all** of you, Jacob, I will surely gather the remnant of Israel ..."

Regathering even from the west:

Hos 11:10 "... He will roar like a lion; Indeed He will roar and His sons will come trembling from the west."

A second regathering (ie, Not the return from Babylon) and no other:

Isa 11:10-11 "... it will happen on that day that the Lord will again recover the second time with His hand the remnant of His people, who will remain, from Assyria, Egypt, Pathros, Cush, Elam, Shinar, Hamath, and from the islands of the sea."

People will be in awe at their prosperity:

Jer 33:6-9 "... I will bring to it health and healing, and I will heal them; **and I will reveal to them an abundance of peace and truth.** I will restore the fortunes of Judah and the fortunes of Israel and will rebuild them as they were at first. I will cleanse them from all their iniquity by which they have sinned against Me, and I will pardon all their iniquities by which they have sinned against Me and by which they have transgressed against Me. It will be to Me a name of joy, praise and glory before all the nations of the earth which will hear of all the good that I do for them, and **they will fear and tremble because of all the good and all the peace that I make for it.**"

Salvation will come to Israel in the land of Israel:

Hos 1:10 ... in the place where it is said to them, "You are not My people," it will be said to them, "You are the sons of the living God."

Ezek 36:33 "... On the day that I cleanse you from all your iniquities, I will cause the cities to be inhabited, and the waste places will be rebuilt."

Ezek 20:40 "For on My holy mountain, on the high mountain of Israel," declares the Lord God, "there **the whole house of Israel, all of them, will serve Me in the land; there** I will accept them ..."
